



UC Presidential Fellowships for Undocumented Graduate Students

The UCI Graduate Division is pleased to announce the 2018 call for UC Presidential Fellowships for Undocumented Graduate Students. These fellowships are intended to fill a critical gap in graduate and professional student support.

Award Amount

Up to four \$5,000 fellowships will be awarded for the period of April 2018 through June 2018.

Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

1. Be enrolled and in good standing in a UCI state-supported graduate program. (NOTE: Law and Medical students are welcome to apply).
2. Be an undocumented, AB540 eligible student.
3. Demonstrate financial need.

Application Process

Applications will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- Demonstration of financial need
- Academic achievements and promise

Application packages should include the following:

- A completed Application Form
- NOTE: A letter of recommendation from a faculty member may be provided, but is completely optional.

Deadline for Submission

Applications must be received by the Graduate Division no later than **Friday, March 2nd, 2018 at 12:00pm (noon)**.
