

Master's Program Funding Models

Academic Master's

- Tuition + Fees + NRST (non-resident)
- Generates a 50% return-to-aid to the campus
- Count toward state-funded enrollments
- May be eligible for Student Support (fellowships, TAships)

Professional Degree Supplemental Tuition (PDST)

- Tuition + Fees + NRST (non-resident)
- Generates 33% return-to-aid to campus via USAP/block funds
- + Professional Fee/ Supplemental Tuition returned to school; approved by the Regents
- Revenue in the form of Professional Fee, but funds restricted to program activities.
- Count toward state-funded enrollments
- May be eligible for some student support (fellowships, TAships)

Self-Supporting Graduate Professional Degree Programs (SSGPDPs)

- One program fee (no NRST); must be approved by UCOP
- Health insurance may be mandatory or optional
- Program fees must cover ALL program costs (faculty, staff, TAs, Registrar, Graduate Division, Library, other campus resources)
- Revenue beyond expenses stays in the department, but is taxed by the campus
- Students in SSGPDPs may be eligible for fellowship/ASE support using program revenues
- Do not count toward state-funded enrollments
