GRADUATE STUDENT ASE FEE REMISSION:

- * For AY 2023-2024, the Academic Student Employee (ASE) fee remission amount for part-time enrolled graduate students is equal to 100% of the Student Services Fee, 50% of the Tuition, 100% of GSHIP (health insurance) fee and 100% of Campus-based Fees.
- * UCI Policy states that Part-Time graduate students (enrolled in 8 units or less) may be appointed as Readers, Tutors or in other appropriate titles. However, combined campus-wide employment cannot exceed 25% time during any academic quarter. Only graduate students who are Full-Time (enrolled in 12 units or more) are eligible for appointment/employment as Teaching Assistants and Associate Instructors.

- **2.** Effective Fall 2018, new undergraduate, professional, and graduate students are assessed the **One-time Document Fee** of \$80. Eligible students are able to use financial financial aid to cover the Document Fee. The Document Fee only applies to new students and is covered by remissions.
- 3. Total Assessment for Non-Residents includes **Non-Resident Supplemental Tuition**, which is NOT covered by ASE Fee Remission. Eligible Non-Resident Ph.D. students who have Advanced to Candidacy are exempt from paying the Non-Resident Supplemental Tuition for a maximum of three calendar years; assessment is equivalent to that of a Graduate Student Resident. - **4.** The <u>UC Graduate and Professional Council (UCGPC) Fee</u> is a non-mandatory fee that graduate students are assessed during the fall (\$3), winter (\$2), and spring (\$2) terms to support the systemwide UC Student Association. Students may elect to opt-out and once the opt-out is elected students will not be charged the fee unless they change their election for a later term. Remissions will cover the UCGPC fee if students don't elect to opt-out.
