- Must be willing to prepare poster and oral presentations of their research at the first and second awards dinner respectively.
- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must have exhibited excellent interpersonal and leadership abilities during their academic program.

Materials Checklist

- A completed Student Biographical Profile with a 100-word student bio
- A current CV
- A statement by the awardee of no more than 2-3 pages in length, describing their research project, progress to date, and plan for completion
- A confidential evaluation of the student by their faculty advisor (this may be included in the faculty advisor letter)
- Letters from the:
 - Faculty Advisor
 - Department Chair
 - Associate Dean
